General Statement of Job Function: Serve as the primary assistant to the Resident Music Director in support of all of Goodspeed's artistic product, including productions at The Goodspeed and The Terris Theatre.

- Coordinate the delivery of materials from rehearsals to and from arrangers and orchestrators
- Update and maintain scores, vocal books and orchestra parts and, with the music directors, assuring materials are accurate and up to date at all times
- Accompany rehearsals as necessary
- Perform in orchestras at the Goodspeed and/or the Terris Theatre when requested
- Program keyboards
- Maintain music department keyboards, computers and peripherals
- Maintain & upgrade music department software
- Obtain and maintain instruments for onstage use when requested
- Participate in load-in and load-out of orchestra rehearsal and performance spaces
- Maintain the music department office in work-ready condition
