General Statement of Job Function: The First Hand assists the Draper in the safe, accurate and timely construction and alterations of assigned costume elements. The First Hand supervises stitchers/costume apprentices in the sewing and construction of assigned costume elements. In addition, the First Hand will assist in supporting the Goodspeed Costume Rental Collection.

Principle Duties and Responsibilities:

- Complete all projects assigned by CSM and Draper in an efficient, safe and timely manner while maintaining the integrity of Designer's vision.
- Assist Draper with fittings, cutting, pattern making, stitching and alterations of assigned costume elements.
- Work with Draper to determine best construction method and techniques.
- Complete hand and finish work as assigned.
- Utilizing the provided Material Safety Data Sheets, practice safe and appropriate use of common chemical based products found in a costume shop including, but not limited to: Dye, Spray Paint, Barge, contact cement, spray adhesives, etc.
- Participate in end of day shop cleaning and organization projects as needed.

Other Duties and Responsibilities:

- Assist CSM and the Costume Rental Collection with pulling, inventorying, maintenance and transportation of costumes for Goodspeed productions and third party rentals.
- When requested, assist with the maintenance and laundry of the costumes for any Terris Theatre or Goodspeed By The River productions.
- When requested and available, fill in backstage as members of the wardrobe crew for productions in cases of illness or planned absences of a Wardrobe Apprentice.
- Maintain a clean and safe workspace.
- Other duties as assigned.

Required Qualifications & Skills: Experience with theatrical costumes; Knowledge and experience in a variety of costume construction techniques and materials; Ability to instruct others on tools, materials, techniques, and practices; Experience with domestic and industrial

sewing machines and sergers; Proficient in hand sewing; Able to work long hours during heavy build and tech periods; Periodic availability nights, weekends, and the occasional Holiday.

Preferred Qualifications & Skills: Ability to work collaboratively and effectively with a wide variety of coworkers at different levels of skill and knowledge; Interest and experience in costume crafts including dying, distressing and millinery; Valid driver's license with safe driving record.
